

Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council Permit Scheme Order 2015

Made 2015

Coming into force 1st October 2015

Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of its powers conferred by section 33A (2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order -

1. This Order may be cited as 'The Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities Order 2015' and shall come into force on 1st October 2015.
2. The Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities which came into effect on 2nd February 2015 under the Traffic Management (Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council) Permit Scheme Order 2014 is varied to comply with the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.
3. Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council acting as the Local Highway Authority for all streets under its control within the whole area encompassed by the authority's boundary approves the Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities which is set out in the Schedule to this Order.
4. The Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities set out in the Schedule to this Order complies with all aspects of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, with all other primary and secondary legislation in relation to Traffic Management Permit Schemes, and does not exceed the powers provided under such legislation.
5. The Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities set out in the Schedule to this Order comes into effect on 1st October 2015.
6. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 shall apply to the specified streets within the Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities
