
The AAP must ensure it is compliant with paragraph 186c of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF), which states that any development that results in the loss or deterioration of irreplaceable habitats, such as ancient woodland and ancient or veteran trees, should be refused. We consider that any policy is not legally compliant or sound unless areas of ancient woodland are excluded from development sites, with appropriate buffers specified, and reserve the right to oppose this policy if it later becomes apparent that unmapped ancient woodland is present within the site boundary.

We would also recommend the Council set out how it will encourage developers to secure measurable net gains for biodiversity where development proposals have not provided Biodiversity Net Gain and how it will ensure these measures are actually delivered.

We welcome that the plan includes a direction for developers to take opportunities to create and improve wildlife corridors and to connect existing and new areas of biodiversity value.



We welcome that all public green spaces will be protected from new development **except** for where the development is necessary to enable the site to be continued to be used, or where the development is for alternative sports and recreational provision where the benefits clearly outweigh the loss of the current or former use. In these circumstances, however, this must not include the felling of or the encroachment upon existing trees in these public green spaces.


The Trust also welcomes the commitment to improving access to and links between public green spaces.
